SUMMER STRING'S CAMP

Beginner group lessons

Requirements: Playing ability is similar to 9th-grade+ music. Students should have learned the following to register (no audition): all beginner scales plus A Major (2-octave), F Major, B-flat Major Scale (2-octave), Natural-minor scales (e, a, b, d, g minors).
