WANDA DUBBS DROST (1954) MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Selection Criteria: A North Platte High School senior in the upper 25% of their class who is interested in a career in health. The recipient will plan to pursue a registered nursing (RN) career working towards a Bachelor's of Science in Nursing (BSN). This scholarship is available to all students meeting the criteria, regardless of financial need. This scholarship is *not* limited to higher education institutions located in Nebraska. The North Platte High School Scholarship Selection Committee will choose the scholarship recipient.

Limitations: One student per year beginning in spring 2003. If a student is not chosen, then the scholarship will be renewed to the previous year's recipient, as long as they are still enrolled in a nursing degree (RN) program.

Amount: Income earned on that fund or \$400 (whichever is greater)

The North Platte Public Schools Foundation, Inc. (NPPSF) will manage and administer the Wanda Dubbs Drost Memorial Scholarship and income may be added to the fund's principal at any time. The donor understands that one percent (1%) of the income earned on an annual basis of the Wanda Dubbs Drost Memorial Scholarship shall be retained annually by the North Platte Public Schools Foundation, Inc. to offset administrative expenses. If a time occurs when there is less than \$400 in the Wanda Dubbs Drost Memorial Scholarship Fund, prohibiting the distribution of the scholarship as described, the remaining balance will be transferred into North Platte Public Schools Foundation's general fund.
